All club events will be Entry-on-the-line, so advance entries will not be required. No advance start sheets will be issued. Entry fees for the above events will be **£5.00** per rider, (£3 of which is CTT levy).

HQ for the 2 early events in March will be the lorry park at Prees Heath Island.

In addition, all open events on "D" courses will count for the BAR competitions. Entries should be made direct to the event organiser (see CTT handbook or website).

Also included are the season long competitions for the associations North Shropshire Wheelers are affiliated to:

- Merseyside Ladies CA
- Shropshire CCA
- West Cheshire Time Trials CA
- Veterans Time Trial Association

You will find that in some instances the same event will qualify for several of these competitions.

The Evening 10 Mile Series on Wednesday evenings is 12 events, with 8 best rides to count. The evening 10 series will be on two courses, the Prees course (D32/10)*, and the Hawkstone circuit (D310/2)*. HQ for all evening events (except the Hillclimb) will be at Prees Cricket and Sports Club in Prees Village. Entry on the line. Start at 7.30 pm on top of the Prees bypass for both courses. Allow 10 mins to ride to the start. Points awarded 10 – 1, best 8 scores to count. Entry fee will be **£4.00** per rider (£3 of which is CTT levy).

*** Cycle Time Trials have passed a new rule about lights on your bike when you race in either Open (Type A) or Club (Type B) events:**

Rear Lights

As most will be aware, at the 2019 National Council AGM, the following motion was passed. "No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users."
